- *Internships are only open to undergraduate LGBTQA students, enrolled as juniors or seniors, who currently attend a college or university in the Eastern Washington/North Idaho area.*
- *Internships are conducted in a mutually-agreed-upon period within the year, not to exceed 30 hours per week or 100 hours total.*
- *INBA Outreach intern applicants must submit two (2) forms of documentation that they identify as LGBTQA person or ally. Documentation can be identified in a news article, GSA membership, or personal letter by a parent, teacher, or advisor. Only one (1) form of documentation can be from the intern applicant's parent.*
